Subject(s): Language and Communication Topic: Parts of a bike Duration: 1 hour Material: Worksheet, the parts of a bicycle		
Content areas / Main key areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nature and environment • Technology • Language and Communication 	Description: To know the parts (the components) of a bicycle is very important if we want to ride our bike in a safely manner. Children learn the technique of riding a bike relatively easily but do they know the parts of a bicycle? Most of them not or they learn it later from their older friends or family members. It is a very good opportunity to teach about the built of a bike during a language or communication lesson, for example: English classes or any other language that is taught in the school. This class is simply teaches the parts of a bicycle for young learners through play and game.

Sequencing & phase objective	Action steps and impulses	Concretized competence expectations	Learning materials
<p>Phase 1 Starter activity</p>	<p>We can start our activity with a warming up song especially in the case of younger students. E.g. I like to ride my bike or any other song about bicycle that we can find online or the ones we know. TIP: For older students we can choose a pop song about bicycle or cycling. We can also act the song (most songs for young children can be dramatized, acted.) Demonstrative video of the song in Hungarian language is attached to this lesson plan).</p>	<p>The learners can</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> enrich their knowledge about the bicycle and its components develop their language abilities, teaching technical vocabulary on a foreign language develop their technical knowledge and apply the knowledge they have learnt 	<p>Printables, bicycle</p>
<p>Phase 2 Main activity</p>	<p>The teacher starts an introductory conversation about bike or biking. He/ She shows a picture of a bike and asks the students if they know what the parts of a bicycle are. The students tries to name the parts. The teacher also can use short videos from youtube with the parts of a bike. (see the links to some videos).</p> <p>TIP: you can use flashcards with the names of the parts. Another good tip is to ask one of the students to bring in his/her bicycle to the classroom (this is in case you have students who are coming to school with bikes). The teacher can easily demonstrate on a real bike the major parts of a bicycle. TIP: always adjust the amount of information to the age of the students. Younger students can learn just the major parts (the most important ones) while older students like to know more details. The teacher can use a matching exercise or even a worksheet. There are various kinds (see tips). TIP: Use always the one that fits your students' age and abilities the best. (e.g.they have to link the word (the part) to the drawing or they have to fill in the blank space under the picture of a part)</p>		

Phase 3 Finishing activity	<p>The teacher can close this lesson with a very simple activity- asking the students to tell a story about them and their bike.</p> <p>TIP:It is always good to ask your students to tell you which were those moments in the lesson that they liked the most. You can ask them to tell you a story (if they have one) when they had to use their technical knowledge about bicycles.</p>
